



2.3. Positioning the Speakers

How you position your speakers depends on where you want to use your HOMEARENA TXR335 speaker system. The most common setup for use with a PC is shown below.





Removable speaker stands are provided with your HOMEARENA TXR335 for use with the satellite speakers, if desired. To attach the speaker stands, slide them onto the speakers as shown above. General speaker positioning guidelines are given below:

Satellites In front of your listening position (e.g. either side of your monitor) and angled towards you. Subwoofer On the floor (e.g. under your desk) or somewhere else where you can reach the controls.

2.4. Connecting to your audio source

You can connect any 2-channel source to your HOMEARENA TXR335 Speaker set. Shown below are typical connections for a 2-channel sound card using the supplied stereo mini to chinch cable. If you want to connect to a DVD player, VCR, hi-fi or other 2-channel source with dual phono outputs you can use the cable the other way round and connect to the 3.5mm LINE IN socket shown above.





When connected to a 2-channel source 2.1 sound output is produced. You will hear stereo sound from the satellite speakers and bass effects from the subwoofer.

To ensure correct output from each speaker check that your output settings from your source are set to 2-channel or stereo output. Refer to the documentation that came with your source unit for details of controlling the output settings.

2.5. Connecting the Speakers


Connecting the speakers of your HOMEARENA TXR335 is a simple task. You connect the two satellites to the main subwoofer unit which houses the amplifier and subwoofer speaker as shown above using the speaker cables attached to each speaker. L (Left) R (Right).

2.6. Using the controls

The following controls for your HOMEARENA TXR335 are positioned on the front and rear of the subwoofer.

VOLUME Adjusts the overall system volume.

BALANCE Adjusts the balance of sound between the left and right channels.

TREBLE Adjusts the treble level of the satellite speakers.

BASS Adjusts the bass level through the subwoofer.

3. Operating and Safety Instructions for HomeArena TXR335

- 1. Make sure the amplifier/subwoofer is properly ventilated from above and below.
- 2. Do not install the amplifier/subwoofer in a confined space such as a bookcase or similar unit.
- 3. Keep the amplifier/subwoofer away from heat sources.
- 4. Don't use the amifier/subwoofer or loudspeakers near water.
- 5. Avoid objects or liquids getting into the amplifier/subwoofer or loudspeakers.
- 6. Avoid sustained periods of high-volume use, as this may damage the loudspeaker cones.

HOMEARENA TXR335 uses a 220-230V AC 50Hz mains supply. Do not attempt to open the HOMEARENA TXR335 amplifier/subwoofer. No user-serviceable parts are inside. For your safety, always obey the warning:

CAUTION - RISK OF ELECTRIC SHOCK - DO NOT OPEN COVER.

4. Electromagnetic Compatibility

5. FCC Declaration

You will be given an RMA (return material authorization) number and information on how to proceed with the return of your damaged product. No TerraTec product will be accepted for repairs without an RMA number and proof of purchase. The sales slip or invoice shall suffice as proof of purchase. The costs for shipping of the product to be repaired by TerraTec shall be borne by the sender.
